3. Read **Lamentations 3:2-41**. How does this passage add to your understanding of God and His management of our sinful world?
4. Read **James 4:13-15**. How would you respond to a Christian who says that thinking as directed in this passage engenders fear in his life? What should the proper response be to this biblical instruction (besides obeying it, of course)?
5. Read **Luke 12:22-31**. How does trusting in God's oversight and management of your life help you to truly and wholeheartedly "seek His kingdom" priorities (v.31)?
