APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. Read **Psalm 33:1-3**. How does the logic of praise “befitting” the upright motivate your resolve and efforts in being thoughtfully thankful? Why is it so appropriate for God’s people to be so thankful?
2. Read **Luke 17:15-18**. Why is ingratitude toward God such a problem, especially knowing that all of this concern to joyfully give thanks is not because God “needs” the attention or adulation from creatures like us?
3. Read **Colossians 1:12-14**. How can and should these truths fuel our worship and thanksgiving to God? Why is it important to not simply give thanks for our temporal blessings?
4. Read **Romans 12:1-2**. What would you say to someone who tells you he feels thankful to God but never serves the ministry of Christ or gives financially to the cause of Christ?
5. Write your own Psalm 136.
