APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. Read **Exodus 33:7-13**. When Moses asked God to reveal His ways, what did Moses ask? How does Psalm 103:7 help us understand what Moses asked? Do you want to be more like the Israelites or more like Moses?
2. Read **Deuteronomy 32:3-4** and **2 Samuel 22:22**. The meaning of “His ways” is different. What is the difference in Deuteronomy 32:4 compared to 2 Samuel 22:22? What do these verses teach us about God and how should we respond?
3. What limitations does **Deuteronomy 29:29** and **Romans 11:33** reveal about our ability to know God? What can hinder us from knowing more about God according to **John 14:21**?
4. Read **Ephesians 1:17-18**; **Colossians 1:9-10** and **2 Peter 1:2, 8**. What did Paul pray for according to these passages? Why did Paul pray for these things?
5. Read **Psalms 119:2-3**. What are we commanded to do in these verses? Verse 2 has a different emphasis than verse 3. What is the difference? What does **1 Chronicles 28:9** and **Hebrews 11:6** tell us to expect when we seek the Lord?
