APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. Read **Luke 9:22**. As we have seen throughout our study of Luke, Jesus prefers the designation “The Son of Man.” When we give that some thought (especially, as in this context, in reference to His crucifixion) how can this bring us a greater sense of the cost of our redemption?
2. Read **Daniel 7:13-14**, **Matthew 26:64-65**, **Acts 7:56**, and **Revelation 1:13-16**. How do these references to the Son of Man lead us to conclude that Jesus is far more than a great earthly king?
3. Read **Hebrews 1:1-4**, **Philippians 2:5-8**, and **1 John 4:1-3**. Why is it problematic for people and religious groups to deny Christ’s deity?
4. Read **John 5:21-23**, **8:56-59**, and **Luke 5:20-24**. How do words and actions like these demonstrate Christ’s divinity?
5. Read **Hebrews 4:14-16**. How does this description of the God-Man give you hope and encouragement?
