## Luke 24

**36** As they were talking about these things, Jesus himself stood among them, and said to them, "Peace to you!" **37** But they were startled and frightened and thought they saw a spirit. **38** And he said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? **39** See my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me, and see. For a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have." **40** And when he had said this, he showed them his hands and his feet. **41** And while they still disbelieved for joy and were marveling, he said to them, "Have you anything here to eat?" **42** They gave him a piece of broiled fish, **43** and he took it and ate before them.

## APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. Read **1 Thessalonians 4:13-18** and **Philippians 3:20-21**. What is lost in the Christian life when we are not specific and thoughtful about the reality of our coming resurrection?
2. Read **Romans 8:18-25**. Though some would suggest that the more one is “heavenly-minded” the less he will be “earthly-good,” what are some of the reasons this passage leads you to think otherwise?
3. Read **1 Corinthians 15:42-49**. What are some of the specific things that boost your anticipation about your future resurrection when reading this passage?
4. Read **Revelation 22:1-7** and **Psalms 16:11**. How does walking obediently on that “path of life” increase your anticipation of the eternal state, and why do you think disobedience hampers it?
